graduated from the Department of Painting at Turku School of Fine Arts in 1997

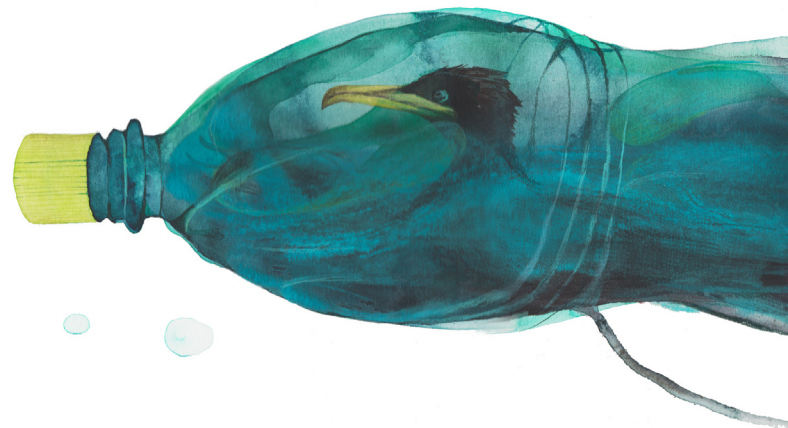
has worked on several public artworks around Finland, and created illustrations and cover images for numerous publications

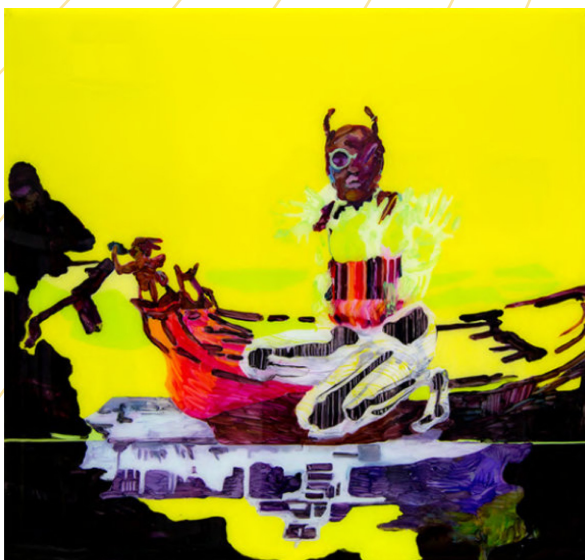

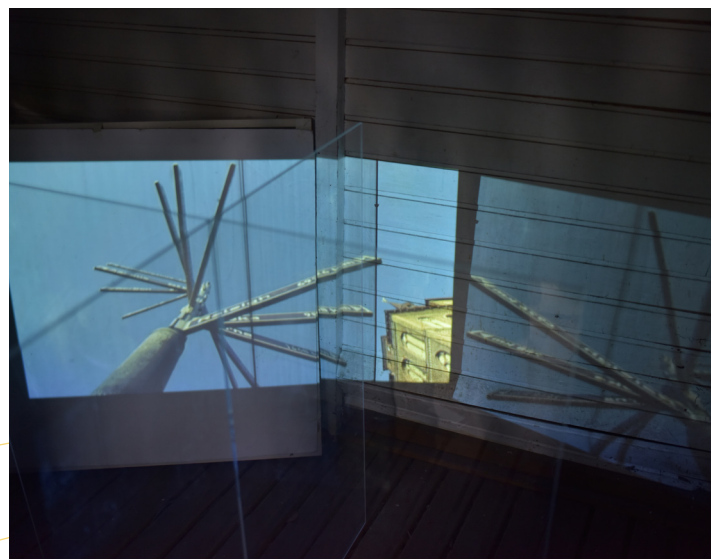

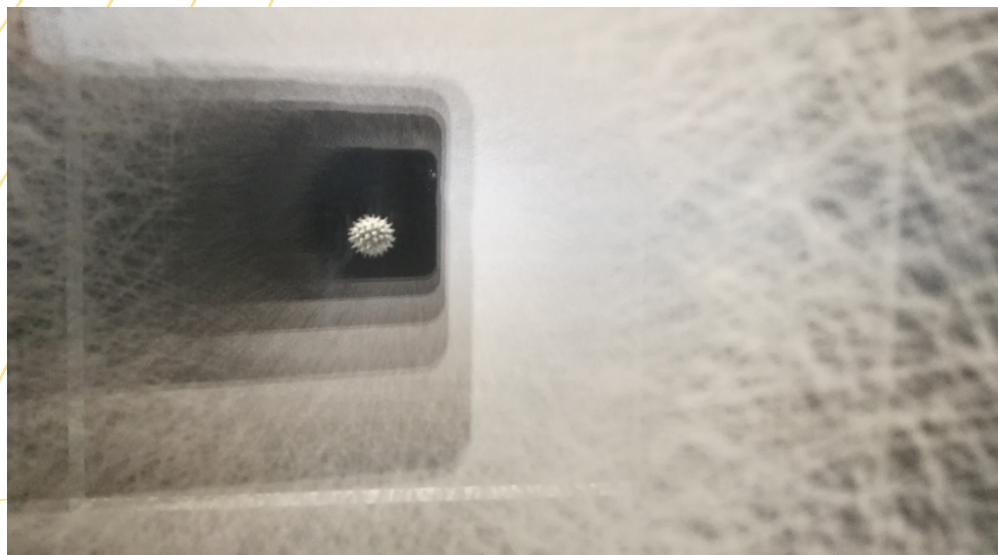
